## 2019-20 SCIP AT-A-GLANCE

*Guadalupe Alternative Programs (GAP) serves communities challenged by transition and poverty through education and enrichment opportunities, social and emotional support, and training that leads to employment.*

The SCIP (School Continuous Improvement Plan) process facilitates our yearly school goal-setting and directs us in monitoring our progress and making modifications along the way in response to the needs of our students. In the spring/summer, we review our schoolwide data with all stakeholders (including students and parents) and create a plan for the next school year.

For the 2019-20 School year, GAP will focus efforts in 4 areas: School Climate, Personalized Learning, Reading and Math.

<b>Math</b>	<i>We will assist our students as they improve their math skills by:</i>

<b>Reading</b>	<i>We will assist our students as they improve their reading level by:</i>
